HM PROCEDURE 100

SUBJECT: CHMJ ANNUAL RALLY COMMITMENT

EFFECTIVE DATE: January 1, 2009

I. PHILOSOPHY:

In order to establish that a Chief is active at USPC rallies it is expected that a CHMJ Chief at least once a year and participate in an additional rally in some capacity at least once a year.

II. PROCEDURE STATEMENT:

To remain an Active CHMJ a Chief must perform the duties of Chief Horse Management Judge at least one rally a calendar year and work in the capacity of Chief, AHMJ or Mentor at a second rally at least once a calendar year.

III. AMPLIFYING INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES:

- A. It is the Chief's responsibility to report adherence to this procedure in their annual CHMJ report.
- B. Failure to comply with this procedure will result in a change in status to Suspended: Temporary.

IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:

- A. The Horse Management Committee Chair(s) shall have responsibility for this procedure.
- B. The Vice President of Instruction shall have oversight of this procedure.
