

Pony Parts

Topic: Pony Parts

Levels: D-1 and D-2

Materials: Wall space, Poster, Fly swatters, Toy ponies

Objective: Teach the Parts of the Pony in a fun and less complicated way.

Introductions: Ask Names, Introduce myself, Explain Objective

Explanation:

1. Poster set up In front of the room with a picture of a horse on It.
2. Pass out toy ponies (instructor will have larger model horse).
3. The students will point, along with me, to places on their ponies. I will put the names of parts on the wall poster.
4. Next the PC'ers will split into two teams and play the fly swatter game. The PC'ers will have fly swatters and the first person to hit the part I say wins. The team with the most points at the end wins. Pass out candy to all kids.

Application: Pass out toy ponies and I will have a large toy pony in the front. The kids point to the parts I put on the poster.

Critique: Ask the peers if they understand the lesson and have any questions.

Exercise: Have the students split into two teams and play the fly swatter game.

Summary/Review: Ask each student to point out 2 pony parts on the model horse given to them at the beginning of the lesson. Encourage kids to use their D Manuals (page 231) to learn the correct names of even more pony parts. Give out candy to everyone. Thank-you!
