Name		Description
Bald Face		WIDE, running past inside of the eyes and beyond the nostrils
Blaze		WIDE, marking, running length of face
Strip		Long, THIN, running length of face Also called: "stripe" If crooked: "race"
Snip		White marking between the nostrils
Star		White mark between the eyes

1. Which marking has the most white? Bald
2. Which marking has the least white? Star and Snip
3. Which marking is found between the eyes? Star
4. Which marking is found between the nostrils? Snip
5. Which 3 markings can run the length of the face?  
Bald, Blaze, Strip
6. Can markings be combined? Yes, and they can run into each other
